


Benjamin Hooper's journey began on a smallholding in Devon, where he developed a love for traditional craftsmanship while learning woodworking fundamentals in family workshops.

With a passion for taking ideas from concept to creation, Benjamin Hooper Design is dedicated to delivering the highest quality products and ensuring every detail reflects your vision.



Our Services are available individually or as part of a complete project package and we will always suggest the best options for your specific requirements.




Initial Consultation


Manufacture

Frequently Asked Questions

How long does the process take?

All our commissions are bespoke and therefore vary in timeframes, however for an average mid size project we can expect:

Design Phase 1 - 3 weeks, including consultations and amendments.

Manufacture 2 - 3 weeks on average, though larger projects may take longer.

Installation 2 - 4 days, however larger projects may require additional time.

What does the design fee include?

- · An onsite consultation and detailed measurements.
- 3D drawings to visualise the design.
- Two rounds of amendments. Additional revisions are available at an hourly rate.

Can you provide a cost breakdown?

Yes, a detailed breakdown can be provided at the end of the design phase, once the final design is approved.

Do you offer repairs or adjustments after installation?

We stand by the quality of our work and will work with you to resolve any adjustments if needed.

Can you match an existing style?

Yes, we can work with existing styles or design references.

What happens if I need to delay?

If delays arise, contact us early. Storage fees may apply if manufacturing is complete.

What's the best way to get started?

Book a consultation through our website or contact us directly.

Why is the design phase sign-off important?

The design sign-off is a crucial step in ensuring that your vision is perfectly translated into the final product. It allows us to finalize material orders, begin production, and secure your manufacturing slot.

Without this step, we cannot accurately schedule manufacturing or installation timelines, as any delays in the design phase can have a knock-on effect.

Do you offer sustainable materials?

Yes, we prioritise using responsibly sourced, high-quality materials.


When can I book an installation date?

Installation dates can only be confirmed after the design phase is signed off and materials have been delivered and inspected for quality. This ensures we can commit to a reliable timeline without unexpected delays caused by material defects or availability issues.

Wood is a natural material, and its inherent variability means each delivery must be thoroughly checked before we move into the manufacturing stage.
